





8 WAYS TO MAXIMIZE YOUR TIME IN THE VILLAGES

here is nothing better than welcoming your grandchildren into town. But what do you do if you need to rent baby equipment, treat a sunburn or respond to an emergency? Find out the answers to these questions and more right here.



HOW TO TREAT SUNBURNS

First of all, make sure to use a heavyduty sunscreen on your grandchild. But sometimes sunburns happen even when we do the best we can to protect them. In that event, here are some tips for you.

- KEEP THEM HYDRATED frequently offer your grandchild water.
- SOAK A TOWEL IN COLD WATER and use that as a compress on their burn for 10-15 minute time intervals.
- MAKE SURE THEY WEAR LOOSE CLOTHING so nothing touches their burn.
- DO NOT EXPOSE THEM TO THE SUN until the burn is completely healed.

DO NOT pop blisters. It could be even more harmful to their sensitive skin.

DO NOT use Vaseline or any other petroleum-based products.

— Call the doctor if any swelling takes place, a fever begins or the child begins womiting.



Thankful For Special Gift

hose numbers mean everything to me, as they define a very special moment in my life.

In fact, it's a moment that changed my life forever—the birth of my first grandchild.

I've heard that you never can understand what it's like to be a grandparent until it happens to you. Five years ago, I had the pleasure of finding out just how true that statement really is.

Young Marley Elizabeth Wilson came into the world in the wee hours of the morning, shortly after my wife, Gigi, and I had been sent home from UF Health Shands Hospital to get some much-needed sleep.

"Nothing's going to happen tonight," the doctor promised, as our daughter Whitney's labor pains remained somewhat erratic.

Forty minutes later, when the phone rang and I saw it was Whitney calling, I wished I'd listened to that inner voice.

"Now!" I heard Whitney scream as I started to make a U-turn in Ocala.

"What do you mean, now?" I asked, as a barrage of unintelligible words came back at me.

I handed the phone to my wife and mashed the gas pedal to the floor. As I was setting the cruise control on 95 mph, I heard Gigi attempting to calm Whitney down. The race was on as my wife assured Whitney we'd be there very soon.

A ton of fractured speed laws and blown red lights later, our car screeched to a stop in front of Shands and my wife made a run for the delivery room. Six minutes later, Marley was born. It wasn't long until tears streamed down my face as I held my granddaughter for the first time. As those huge brown


eyes looked up at me, I could see us flying kites or riding in my Jeep together. I could just imagine us playing with Hot Wheels cars together and I easily could envision Gigi and I taking her school shopping every year.

Since that day, Marley and I have shared many special moments. She once challenged me to a drag

race – her little electric car against my 1973 Mustang Mach 1 muscle car. She was on the sidewalk and I was on the street. As I revved my engine, she flashed me a thumbs-up sign. So much for intimidating the kid who defines cool.

A few minutes later, I'd lost my first drag race. And just for good measure, I lost a second one going back down the street

going back down the street. But as she climbed into my arms to give the No. 1 sign for a photo, Granddad couldn't have been happier.



Another time, Marley and I also shared a special moment at a local restaurant that has a rather large toy selection in the lobby. As we waited for our meal, she grabbed my hand and asked if we could go "look" at toys. Knowing that's a code word for "purchase" toys, I grabbed my wallet and off we went.

Marley selected a small tea set and politely asked if she could have it. The answer was yes, of course, so I headed for the cash register to settle up.

That's when I heard that precious voice say, "Oh, and granddad, all of this." I turned around just in time to see her hand going in a circle around several dolls, doll clothes and a table-and-chair set for them to sit in.

A few minutes later we returned to the table with two large bags full of "all of this." As my wife asked me what happened, all I could do was smile. Breakfast cost \$175 that morning, but it was worth every penny.

There are so many more Marley moments. As a 2-yearold, she once climbed the stairs of our house, moaning in pain with every step. When asked what she was doing, she smiled and said. "Granddad!"

When she wanted to go out to eat at the restaurant where her mother works and my wife didn't answer her quick enough, she told her she'd just ask granddad because, "he always says yes."

Yes, it's true that you never understand what being a grandparent means until it happens to you. It's a feeling that I cherish every single day and one that I hope to experience again down the road.

Story time in The Villages happens in so many places. You can find Villagers swapping stories around their kitchen tables, in restaurants, on the golf course and when their grandchildren come to town.

FAMILY HISTORY

Bev Chartier, a Village of Mira Mesa resident and secretary of The Villages Genealogy Club, recalls telling stories to family members, then receiving questions she couldn't answer.

"My nephew, Stevie, is the one who got me interested in genealogy," Bev said. "He told me one day that his Gram told him there was aboriginal lineage in the family. We are French, so I told him we didn't, but when I asked my aunt, who was 90 years old at the time with a mind like a steel trap, she said of course we have aboriginals in the family."

Bey found even more information one afternoon as she was cleaning her aunt's home. She came across some old photos and asked her aunt if she wanted them. Her aunt told her she was holding proof of her aboriginal history.

The woman in the photo was a full-blooded aborigine and, as Bev researched her lineage further, she found descendents from Mohawk, Iroquois and Algonquin tribes.

"Now my grandson wants to know about the Chartier side of the family. I am working on that right now," Bev said. "I have it back to 1595. It's very interesting. Up in Massachusetts where I am from, there is a Mohawk trail — the actual trail the aborigines used to come down from Canada. This year, they activated the outpost they have up there. I would love to travel up there next summer to see it."

GRANDCHILDREN AND FAMILY HISTORY

Tips from Ruth on ways to get your grandchildren interested in family history

- Show them old photos, identify relatives and tell them stories about those people.
- Organize a photo album of yourself and use mementos such as graduation or theater programs. Things like 4-H ribbons are another great way to help your grandchildren visualize family history.
- Write stories in your photo album. Ruth wrote stories about a family farm in one of hers.
- Photos of old machinery or relatives working at their careers also grab interest. For example, if a relative was a teacher and a grandchild also is interested in teaching, it creates a connection.
- Use newspaper clippings. Ruth has a newspaper clipping from when her father met her mother during a wedding and rolled his vehicle.

KEEPING CHILDREN CONNECTED TO THEIR FAMILY

Ruth Wible, of the Village of Liberty Park, also enjoys talking to her grandchildren about their family history. She feels it can be a great anchor for children that keeps them connected to their family.

"I've been trying to get them interested. I just feel like it gives you a place to be," Ruth said. "By the time I was 9, all my grandparents were deceased so I was curious and my dad's older sister was very interested (in genealogy). She was looking for someone young like I was to hook, and I was it. You have to find someone in the next generation to keep it going."

Ruth's great-grandmother enjoyed journaling family history. She would write to whomever she could think of and only wrote down facts if she could find two sources who said the same thing. Ruth's aunt would talk to her about family history while they cooked meals and Ruth enjoyed peppering her with questions.

Hot Fudge Topping

INGREDIENTS

- * **3** unsweetened chocolate squares
- * 1/4 teaspoon salt
- * 1 can sweetened milk
- * 1/4 cup sugar
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla
- * 1/2 cup hot water
- Put all items in microwave container and cook until creamy, stirring frequently.
- 2) Serve hot over ice cream.

Strawberry Topping

INGREDIENTS

- * 4 cups fresh strawberries
- * 1/4 cup sugar
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla
- * 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- * 1 1/2 teaspoons cornstarch
- * 1/4 cup water
- 1) Combine all of the above in a saucepan.
- 2) Simmer on low until thickened.

Caramel Topping

- * 1/2 cup brown sugar
- * 1/2 cup sugar
- * 1 tablespoon flour
- * 1/2 cup cream or half and half
- * 1/2 cup butter
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1) Mix sugars and flour together in a saucepan. Add cream, butter and vanilla.
- 2) Bring to a low boil, and boil 2 minutes.

Homemade Whipped Cream

- *8 ounces heavy cream
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla
- * Powdered sugar
- 1) Before starting, chill your mixing bowl and whisk attachment in the freezer for a few hours or overnight.
- 2) Pour the heavy cream into the mixing bowl, and begin whisking on high. Add the vanilla (you can add a little more to ensure you really taste vanilla), then gradually add the powdered sugar. Stop your mixer every once in a while to see if the mixture is sweet enough. Start with small amounts you always can add more, but you can't take it away if there is too much.
- 3) After you have figured out how sweet you want it, whisk on high until your cream starts to thicken, at least a couple of minutes. Keep an eye on it, because you can over mix. Over mixing will cause a strange, almost sticky consistency.
- 4) After whipping it up nice and fluffy, store it in the fridge. It will keep for a few days, and it makes a good amount, so you have some time to finish it or bake more things to put it on.



Waffle Sundae

- * 1 1/2 cups cake flour
- * 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- * 1/2 teaspoon salt
- * 1 egg, room temperature
- * 1/4 cup sugar (or more if you want them to be sweeter)
- * 2 tablespoons butter, softened
- * 2 tablespoons shortening, butter flavor

- * 1/2 cup half and half, room temperature
- * 1/4 cup buttermilk, room temperature
- * 1/2 cup milk, room temperature
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- * 1 teaspoon butter flavoring
- * 1/2 teaspoon almond extract
- * 1/2 cup finely crushed pecan pieces
- 1) Mix all ingredients together and pour into a waffle maker. Cook until golden brown.
- 2) Then, while still warm, top with vanilla ice cream, chocolate and caramel sauces, bananas and pecans.





Cookie Ice Cream Sundaes

- * 1 cup sugar
- * 1/2 cup brown sugar
- *** 2** eggs
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla
- * 3/4 cup canola oil
- * 3 tablespoons margarine
- * Pinch of salt
- * 2 cups self-rising flour
- * 1 cup chocolate chips

- 1) Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2) Line two cookie sheets with baking parchment paper.
- **3)** In the bowl of your mixer, blend sugars and eggs. Add vanilla, oil, margarine and salt. Beat until a thick batter forms.
- **4)** Add flour one 1/2 cup at a time. Add chocolate chips.
- 5) Scoop about a teaspoon of cookie dough and flatten slightly onto prepared cookie sheets. Bake for approximately 10 minutes or until just the edges are slightly golden.
- **6)** Transfer immediately to a wire cooling rack. Then while still warm, sandwich your favorite ice cream in between 2 cookies and enjoy.



THE RULES OF GOLF CART SAFETY

hen your grandchildren hit the ripe old age of 14, they are ready to drive on the golf cart paths. But there are rules you need to follow to get the most out of your experience. Teaching your grandchildren about golf-cart safety and riding around with them can serve as a bonding experience.

- A golf cart is defined as a motor vehicle that is designed for operation on a golf course or for sporting or recreation, and is not capable of exceeding 20 mph. While the operator of a golf cart does not have to be a licensed driver, the driver must be 14 or older.
- Golf carts may not cross or drive on U.S. Highway 27/441, County Road 466, County Road 466A, Griffin Avenue or any other road with a posted speed limit of 35 mph or higher. Low-speed vehicles can be operated on a road where the speed limit is 35 mph or less. A golf cart can be operated on a state road that has been designated and marked for golf cart use.
- Golf carts must use the multimodal trails adjacent to El Camino Real, Buena Vista **Boulevard, Morse Boulevard, County Road 466 and County** Road 466A. These roadways can be crossed in a golf cart only by using the marked tunnels. The only exception is that golf carts can cross El Camino Real at the traffic light between Enrique Drive and Botello Avenue. In addition, while golf carts are not permitted to travel

- on Rainey Trail (County Road 472), they are permitted to cross between Lynnhaven and Miona Shores Drive. LSVs are permitted to travel on Rainey Trail since the speed limit is only 35 mph.
- On streets within The Villages with a posted speed limit of 30 mph or less, golf carts should be driven in the marked diamond lanes or along the right-hand edge of the street if there is no marked lane.
- Do not allow anyone to ride standing in the vehicle or on the back platform of the vehicle. Arms and legs should be kept inside the vehicle at all times.
- When making a left turn, after signaling your intentions, carefully merge with vehicular traffic just prior to the intersection and turn using the proper signal and turn lane, where available. Anywhere that signage or road markings provide such direction, golf-cart traffic always should merge with vehicular traffic. Golf carts should yield to other vehicular traffic in all cases.
- Golf carts and LSVs are not permitted to travel on sidewalks.
