All of our events will be held in the Broadmoor West Meeting Area. The opening reception Sunday night is in the Mountain View Terrace. All conference sessions will be held in Rocky Mountain A&B, and registration is in the Rocky Mountain Foyer. For those attending the Family Owners Meeting on Saturday, those sessions are in the West Ballroom A&B, and registration is in the Mountain View Foyer. SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Your safety is our top priority. We want our attendees to enjoy time engaging with other attendees in a safe environment and we are carefully monitoring the developments regarding COVID-19 and following CDC and local guidelines. Additionally, The Broadmoor has established protocols to ensure the safety of its guests, and the America's Newspapers staff is implementing the best practices from leading associations to also ensure the safety of attendees.

Safety protocols for the meeting include:

- You will be required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test taken no more than 72 hours prior to arrival. (Vaccinated guests may email a scan of their vaccination record card to psheffield@newspapers.org in advance if they prefer.)
- We are recommending masks in all conference settings for attendees, staff and guests. Masks and hand sanitizers will be available throughout the conference.
- We will provide a wristband system that allows each attendee to specify the level of social distancing they prefer.
- Conference seating will be socially distanced.

We will continue to monitor the CDC's recommendations and adjust our plans if needed in order provide an engaging experience while keeping the safety needs of our attendees a priority. All individual health information will be kept confidential.

GETTING THERE

The hotel is 15 minutes from the Colorado Springs airport, and 90 minutes from Denver International. Round-trip and one-way shuttle service can be arranged through The Broadmoor's transportation department once you have finalized your flight plans. Valet parking at The Broadmoor is available to all overnight guests for \$35 per night. Based upon availability, Valet parking for those visiting the hotel's restaurants, shops or meeting space is complimentary.

The overnight self-parking fee for hotel guests is \$25 per night with full in and out privileges. Day charges are \$2 for the first 30 minutes, with an additional \$2 per half hour up to 10 hours or \$12. Any parking exceeding that amount of time will be tallied at a maximum daily charge of \$25 per day.
